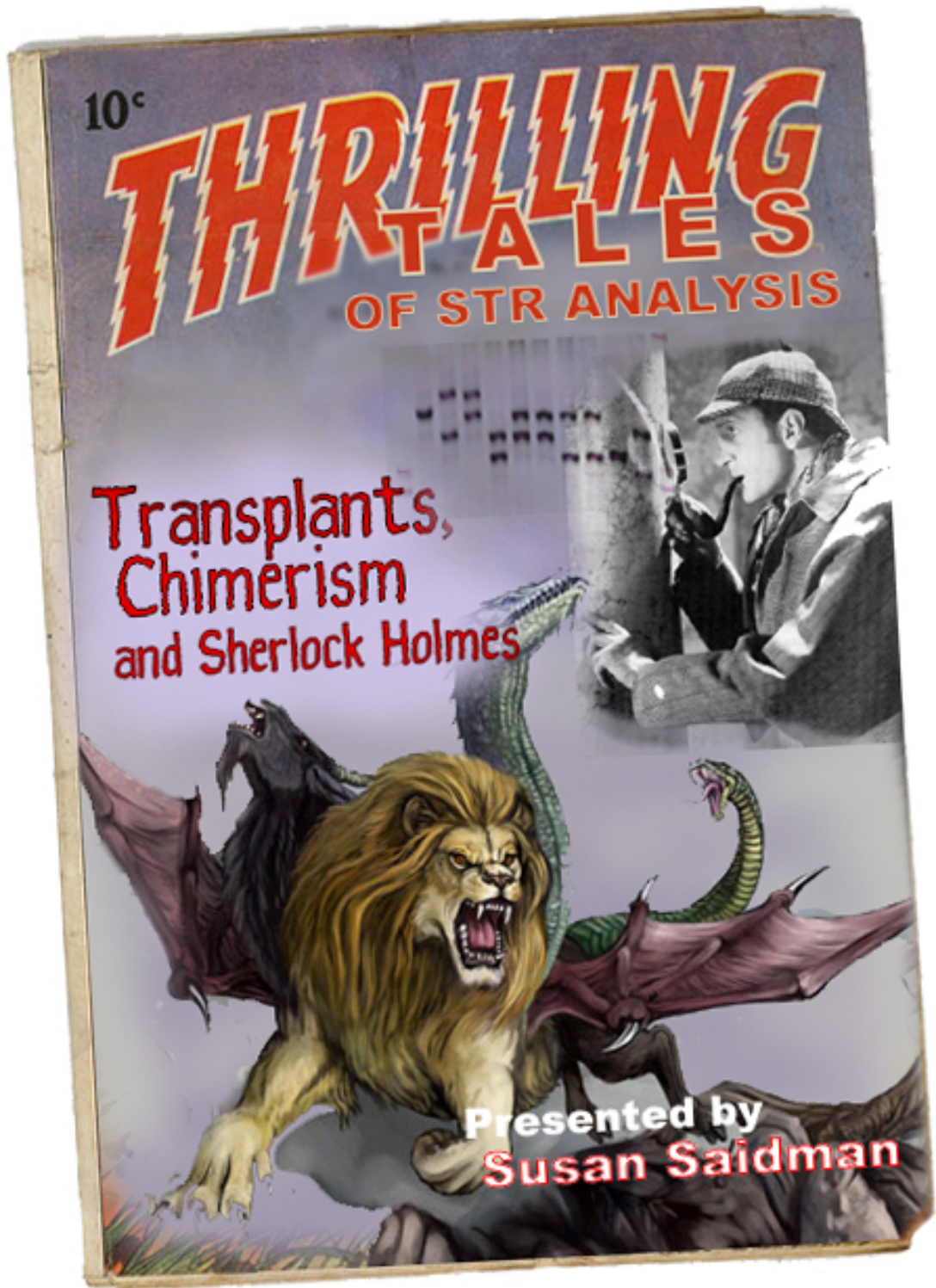


2004-2005 TECH LECTURE SERIES: JANUARY
